Return to Curling

- Locker rooms: We are following local ordinances for the downstairs locker room area.
- Arrive Prepared to Curl: Dressed, stretched and with a duffle bag for a change of shoes.
- Masks: need to be worn on the ice and the upstairs viewing area. For the downstairs area wearing masks will be determined by local ordinances.
- Game Start Positions Alternate End Game Starts: Assign games to start at alternating ends of the ice to reduce pre-game congestion behind the hacks and backboard areas. (Have sheet 2 start away from the glass) If there are only two games, they will be played on sheets 1 and 3.
- **Sweepers:** Teams should only utilize one sweeper at a time. The sweepers for the non-throwing team should remain socially distanced.
- Between Leagues: Teams leaving the ice from the early shift should avoid gathering in the upstairs viewing area where the second shift curlers are waiting for their draw to begin. Once all second shift games have started people can return to the viewing area if they choose (with masks on).
- Sanitation: All club equipment: rocks, brooms, stabilizers, ice prep equipment, ect. will be wiped down before each shift. For brooms and stabilizers, the person using it needs to clean it.

Post-Curling

o Socialization

For those that wish to socialize after your game you may do so downstairs. The downstairs area will follow local ordinance rules. If you want to come up stairs you must wait for the viewing area to be cleared of curlers waiting for their shift to start. The mask requirement will be in effect for those socializing in the upstairs area.

Additional Guidance

- Positive COVID case
 - If anyone tests positive for COVID they will need reach out to their league night chair or board member. The board will then let all club members know that

there was a member that tested positive and any night they were at the club. The name of the infected person will remain confidential.

- Refunds

- o If we have to cancel the season, then the curler can ask for a pro-rated refund of their membership dues.
- o If any individual decides that they cannot continue to curl they may send a request for a pro-rated refund to the board for review.

Non-Members

- Non-Members must follow all club guidelines and have to be accompanied by a club member (1 per member).
- Any non-member curling needs to approved by board.
